In 2008, the organizers of *Violence Transformed* came together again and took *Violence Transformed 2008* beyond the Statehouse into other venues.

*Violence Transformed 2009* will entail significant expansion. This year's Statehouse Exhibit (Doric Hall April 27-May 1, 2009) will serve as the centerpiece of a series of coordinated events, performances and exhibits in diverse settings. During April and May, the Cambridge Art Association, the Museum of the National Center of African-American Artists, the Cloud Foundation, the Juvenile Justice and Youth Advocacy Program of Wheelock College, and Resnikoff Gallery of Roxbury Community College will each host *Violence Transformed* exhibits. And, a series of performances at The Cambridge Hospital will introduce and conclude the 2009 season of *Violence Transformed*.
